1. Encourage all children to achieve their full potential.

- 2. Provide an exciting, relevant curriculum which is broad and balanced.
- 3. Provide a safe, welcoming, caring and disciplined environment.
- 4. Contact parents if we are concerned about attendance, punctuality, school work, behaviour or uniform.
- 5. Inform parents of children's progress through teacher meetings and an end of year report.
- 6. Keep parents informed through monthly newsletters and an up to date website.
- 7. Provide a range of extra-curricular activities.

- 1. Take responsibility for your own behaviour in and outside of school.
- 2. Use online technology in school and at home sensibly and responsibly.
- 3. Read daily and hand in homework on time to a high standard.
- 4. Listen to and respect all adults.
- 5. Work hard and produce work to a high standard in all lessons.
- 6. Wear the correct uniform and shoes to school and have the correct PE kit.
- Ensure your child attends daily with the correct equipment (including water bottle which is filled daily at home with water).
- 2. Inform the school office, on the first day of absence if my child is unable to attend school due to illness.
- Regularly check your child for headlice and inform the school office if they are being treated for headlice.
- Attend parents' evenings and make every effort to support school events.
- Ensure that personal details are kept up to date: current home address, telephone number and emergency contact numbers.
- Inform the school if there are any changes at home which may affect your child's work or behaviour. 6.
- If travelling by car, ensure that your car is parked sensibly and not in the bus bay, blocking drives or on 7. yellow road markings.

Reading and Homework

- 1. Read daily with your child and record details in their Reading Record.
- 2. Support your child with the learning of their times tables and spellings weekly.

Behaviour, uniform and jewellery

- 1. Support the school's Behaviour Policy and any sanctions issued.
- 2. Ensure your child wears correct school uniform and it is clearly named.
- 3. Understand children will be required to wear school pumps if they do not have appropriate footwear.
- 4. Understand children will be asked to remove make-up, inappropriate jewellery and hair accessories.
- I give permission for my child to watch DVDs, films and clips from films and documentaries a teacher has selected as appropriate which may have a PG or 12 rating.
- I understand that my child will visit local places (e.g. Morecambe High School, Happy Mount Park, supermarkets etc) of interest and that consent will not be sought each time.
- I would like my child to take part in cooking and food tasting activities and understand that it is my responsibility to provide up to date allergy / medical information.
- I give consent for **photos** and **videos** of my child to be used by the **school** (e.g. newsletter, TV in foyer, website, Facebook page and prospectus). Only first names will be published with photos and videos.
- I give consent for photos of my child to be used by the local media. It is possible that they will wish to publish the child's full name, age and the school name in the caption for the picture.
