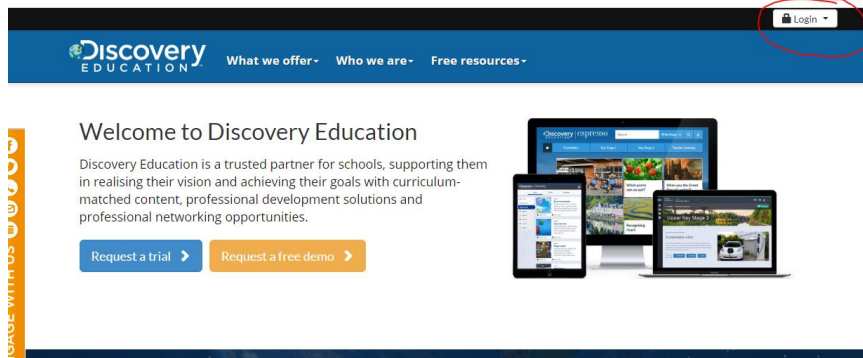
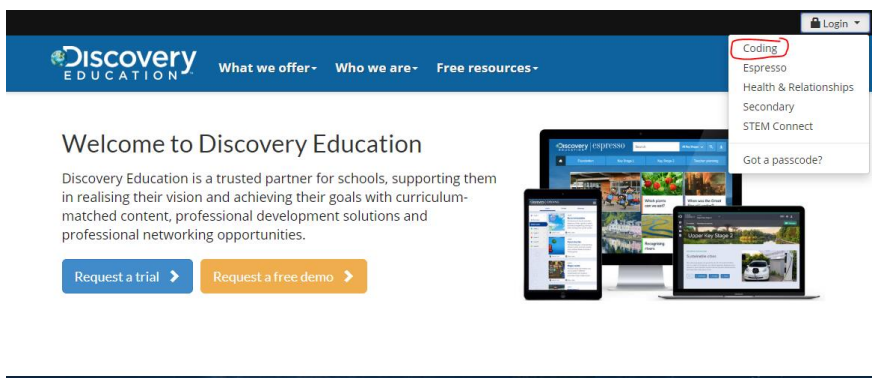

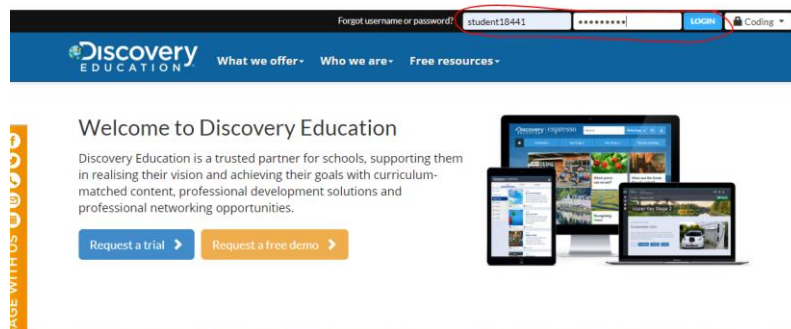
1. Visit [www.discoveryeducation.co.uk](http://www.discoveryeducation.co.uk) and click 'Login' on the top right hand side of the screen.

4. The children have been working on coding 2.0 and the levels correspond to the year groups (e.g. Year 4 work on level 4 and Year 6 work on level 6).
